They focus on specific, annual charges and report progress at Board of Education meetings periodically throughout the year.

The Technology Committee meets to discuss the use of technology within the Rye City School District. The Committee typically meets virtually five to six times a year on Tuesdays from 4:00-5:30 p.m. The first meeting is November 9th. A complete meeting schedule will be provided to all committee members.

The Technology Committee Charge for 2021-22 is as follows:

- Initiate a cohesive vision for the use of technology within the Rye City School District
- Propose and evaluate potential hardware and software products for use in the District and make recommendations to the Superintendent
- Research, discuss, and recommend professional development opportunities for teachers and administration members
- Develop and analyze an internal survey regarding the state of technology availability and usage within the Rye City School District, if appropriate
- Review and submit a new Technology Plan
