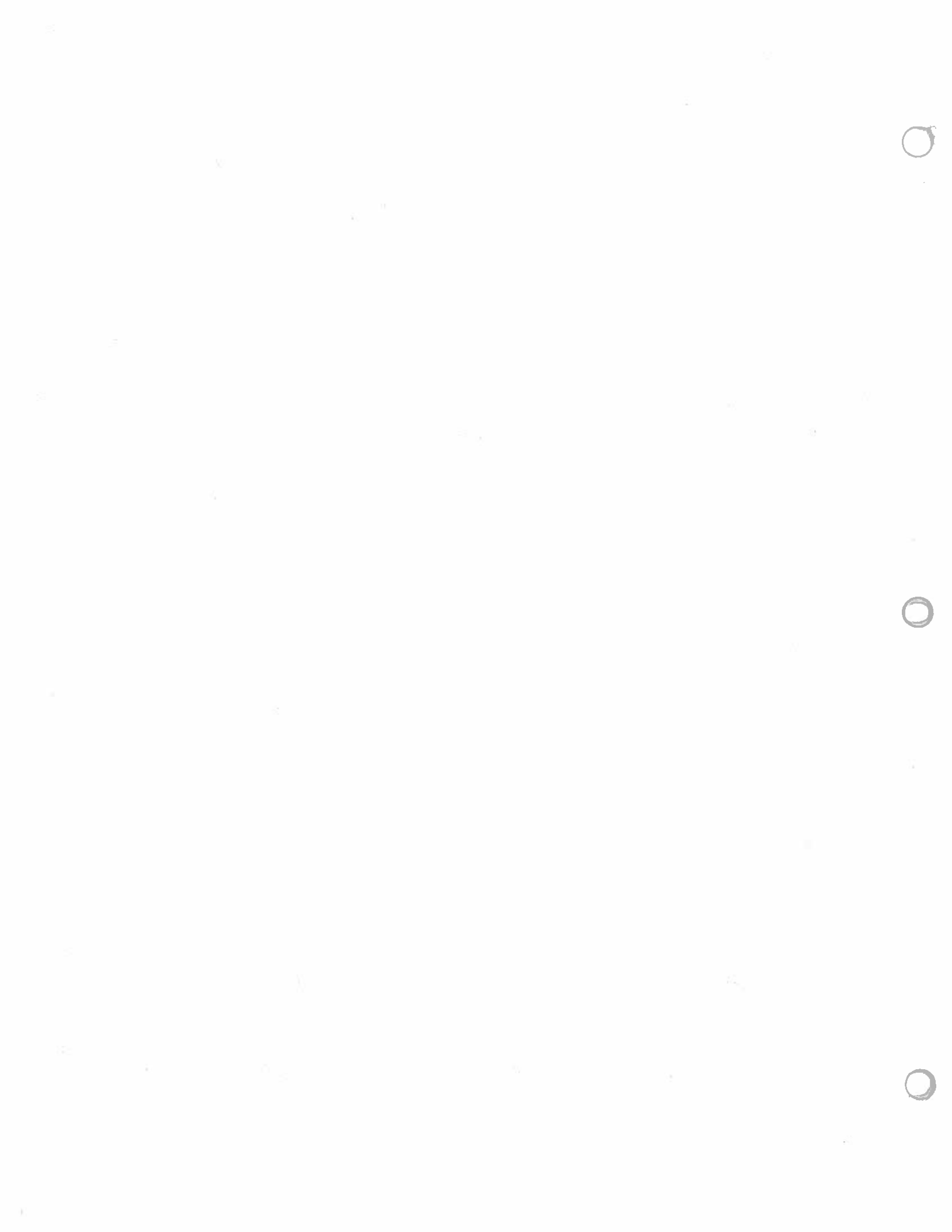
Comments: MORE THAN 50% OF THE MALL TREES HAVE DIED OUT. WHAT TREES REMAIN ARE IN DECLINE, HAVE A LIMITED CANOPY AND FAR FROM SPECIMEN QUALITY. AS THE MALL AND PLAYLAND ARE BEING EXTENSIVELY RESTORED THE TREES WILL BE FURTHER IMPACTED. THE PLAN CALLS FOR PLANTING 46 SWAMP WHITE OAKS AT A 1" 9" CAL. WHICH IS A LARGE TREE TO START WITH AND WILL MAKE AN IMMEDIATE IMPACT.

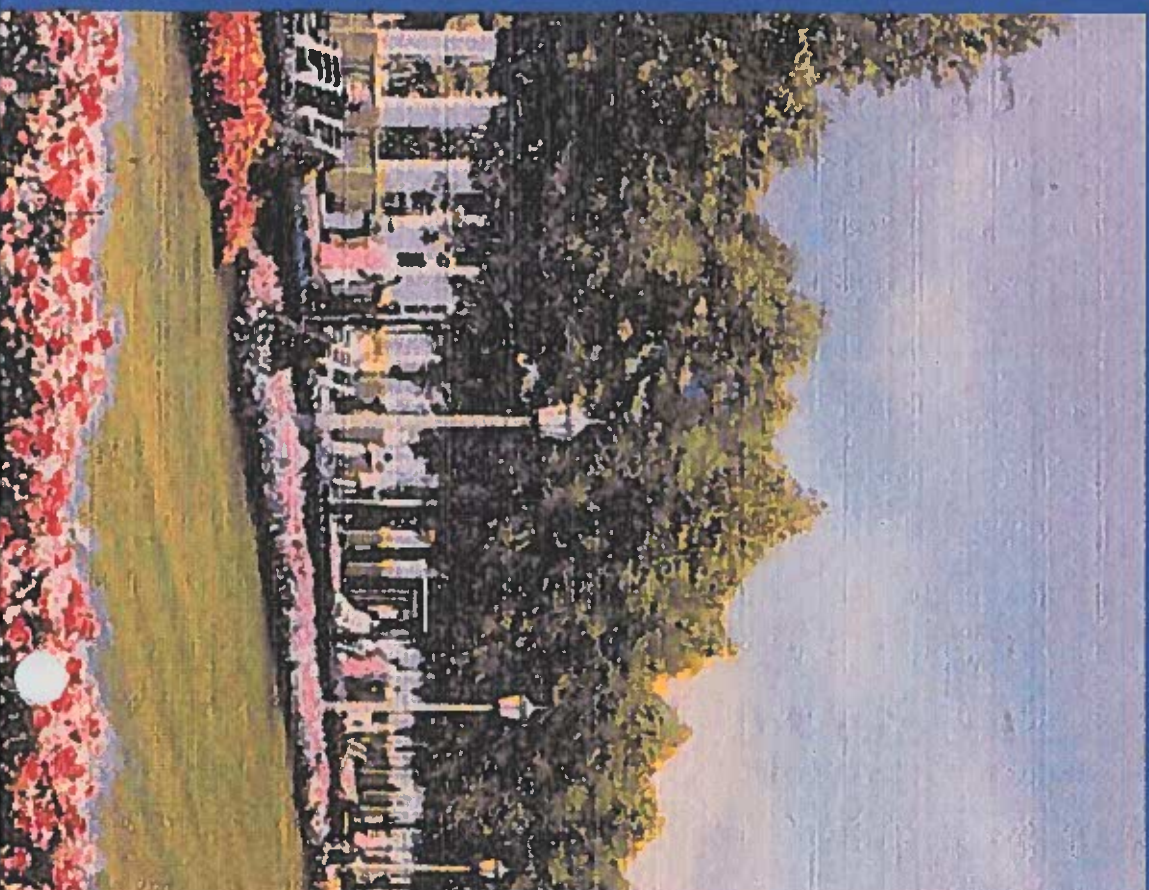

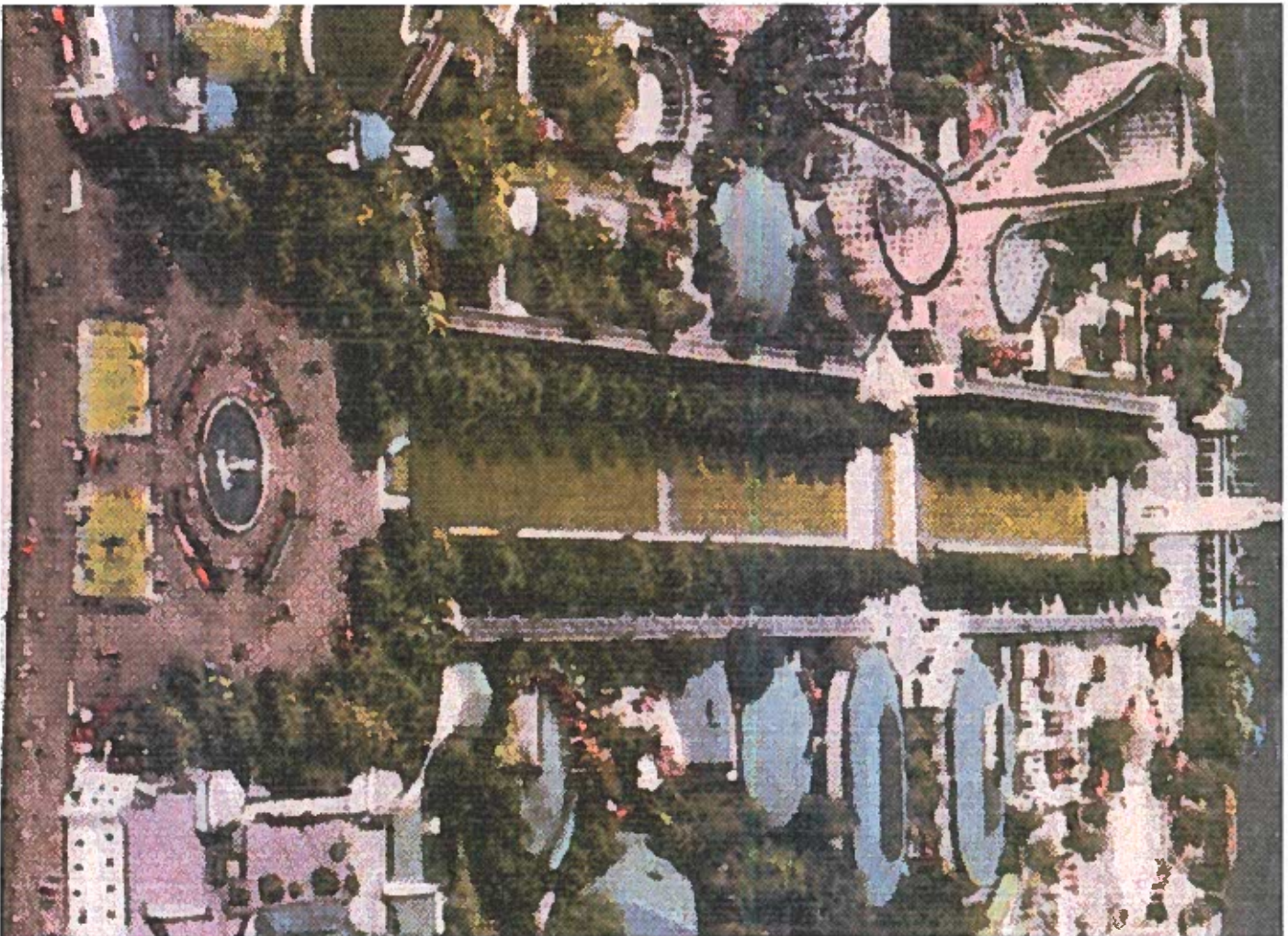

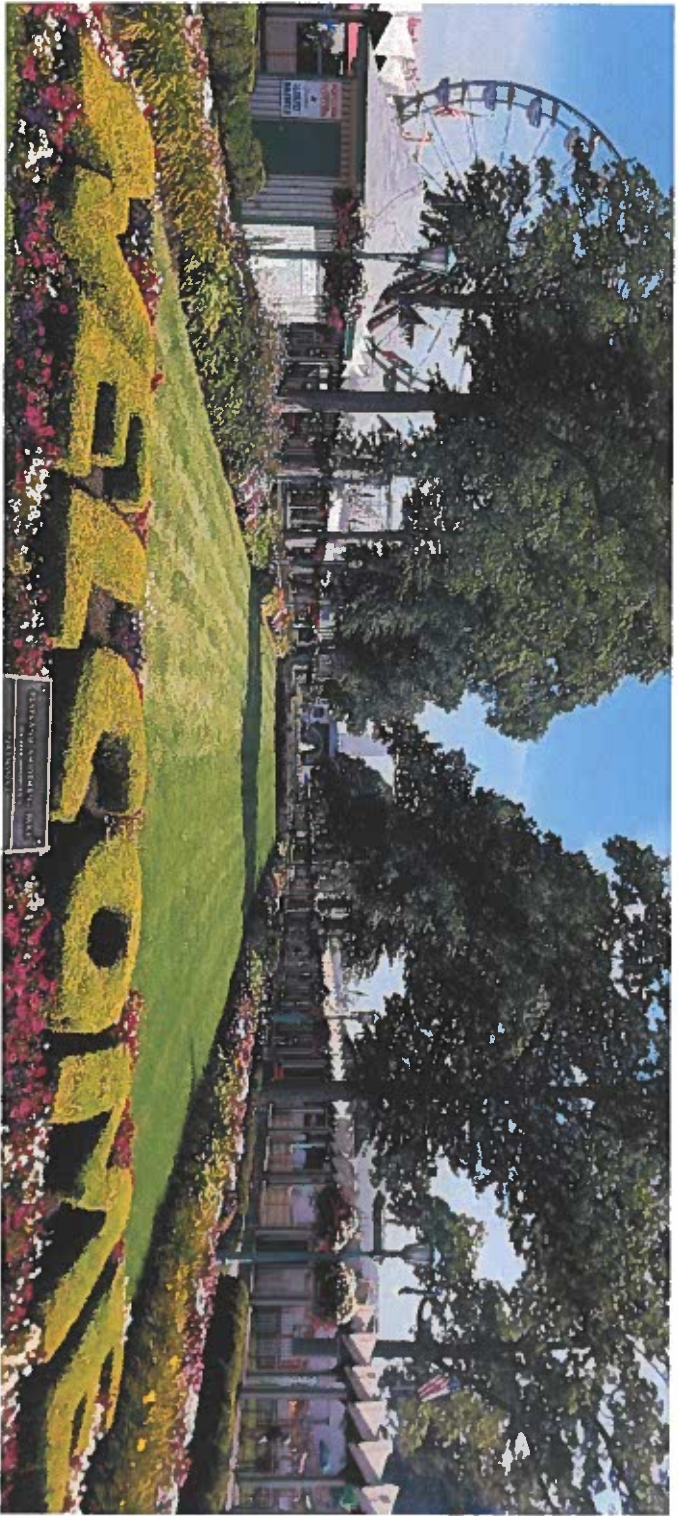




Entrance to the Tumble Bug showing the colonnade



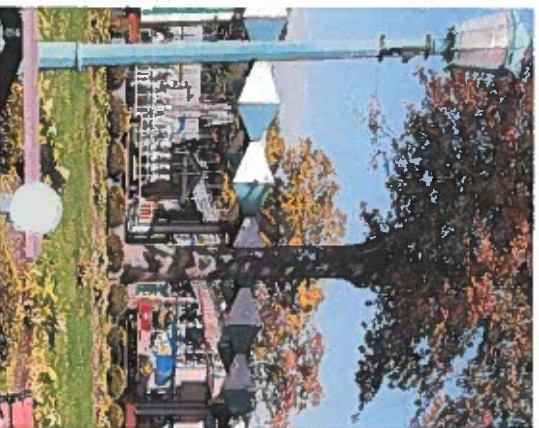
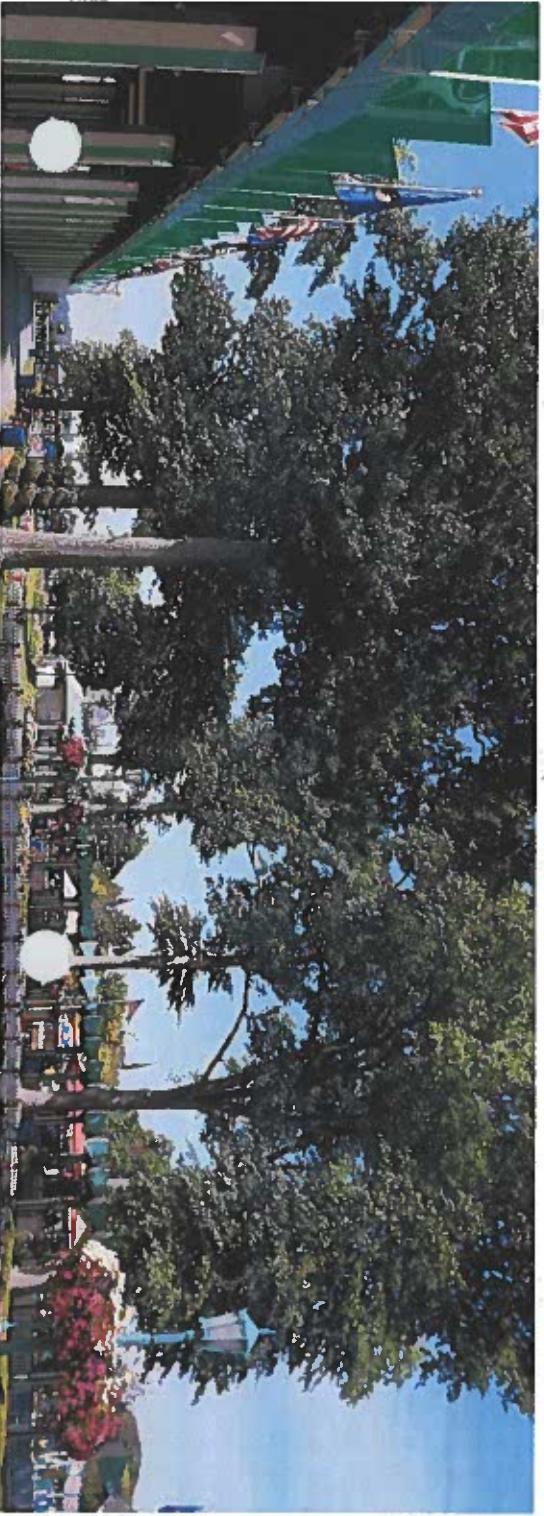

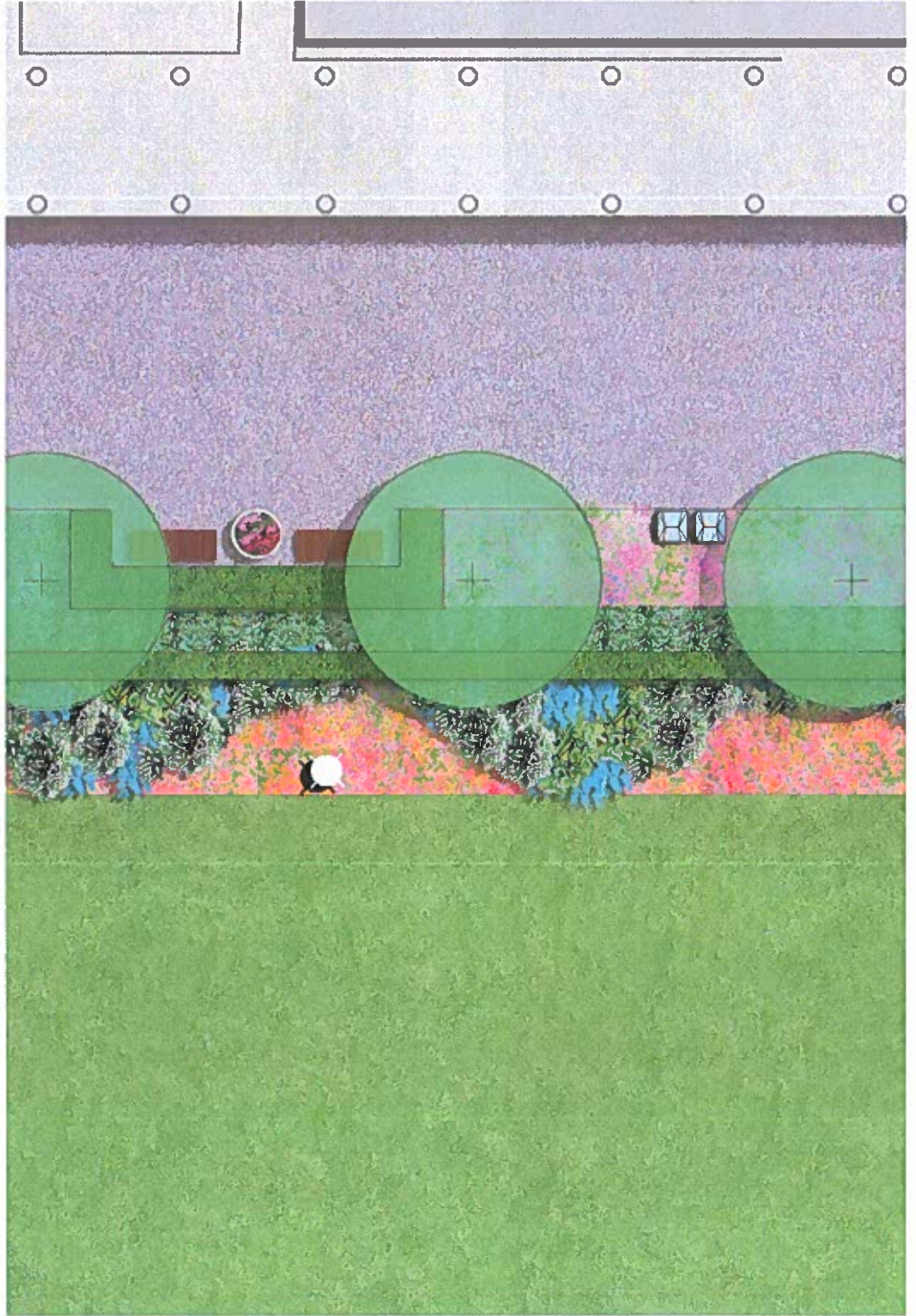
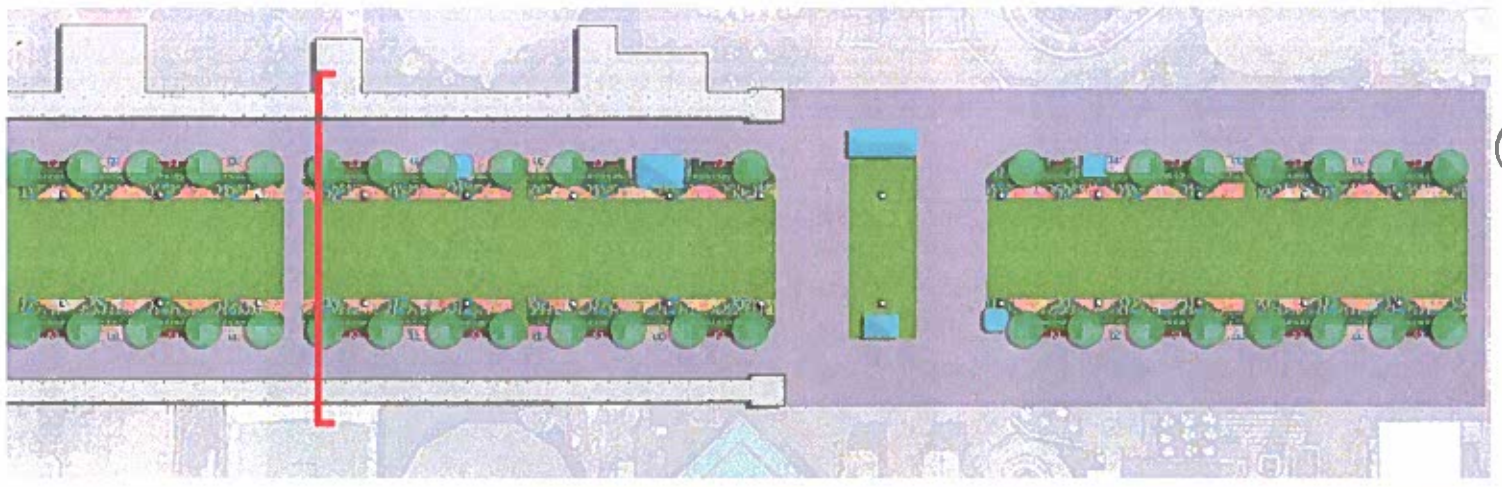


Existing entrance view down center axis of the Mall

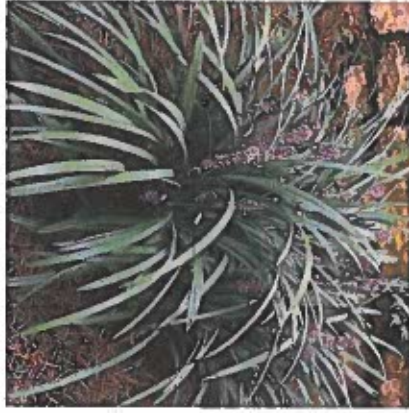
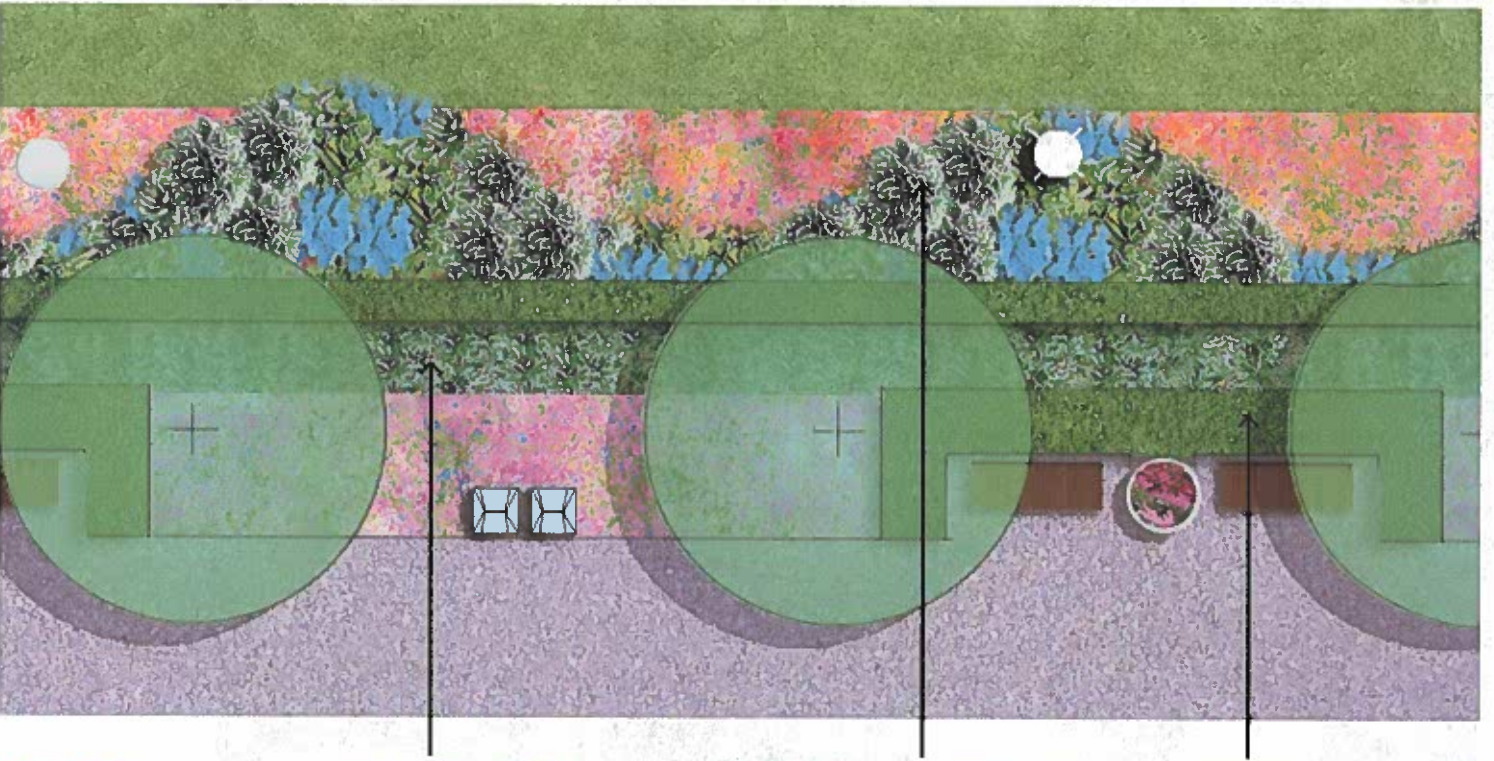


View down the East column

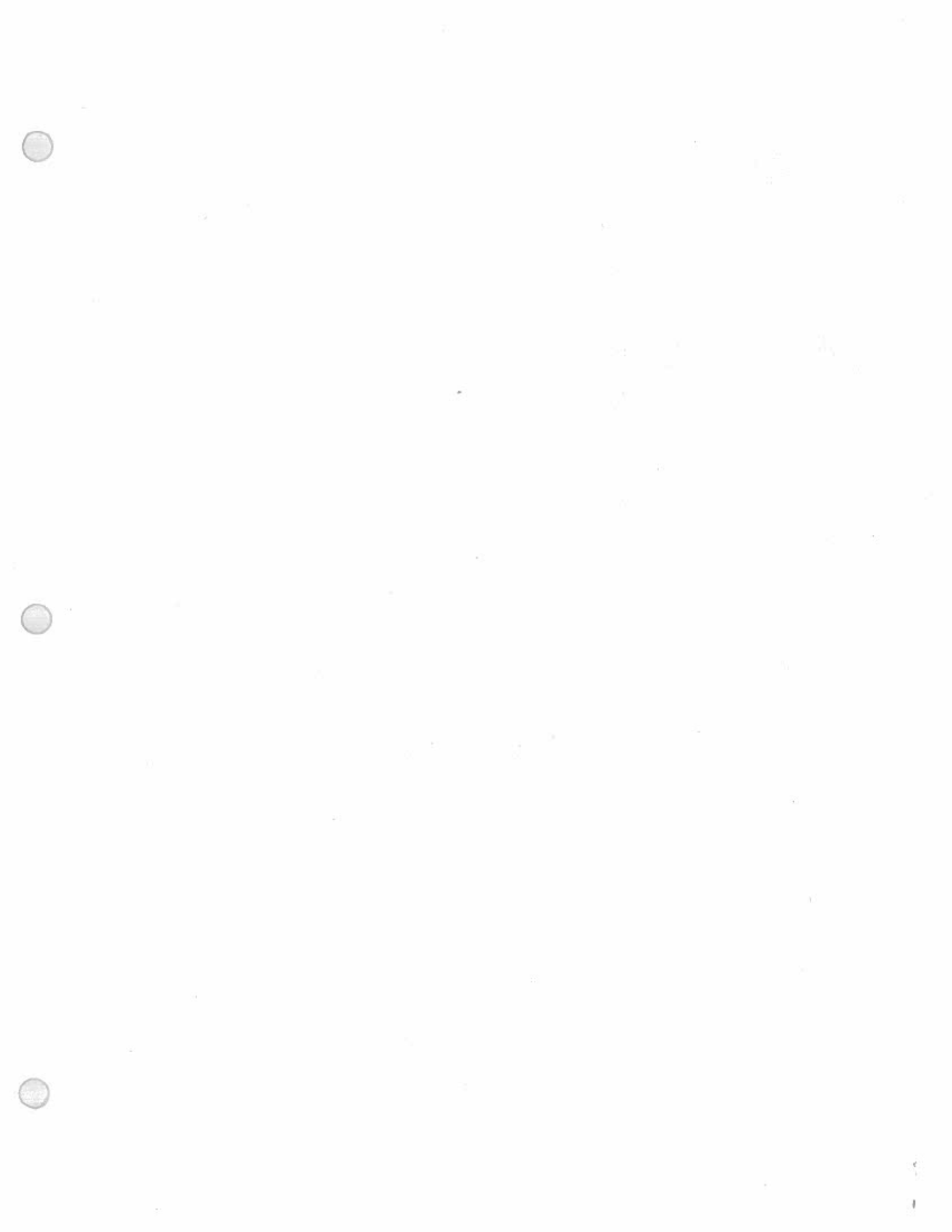




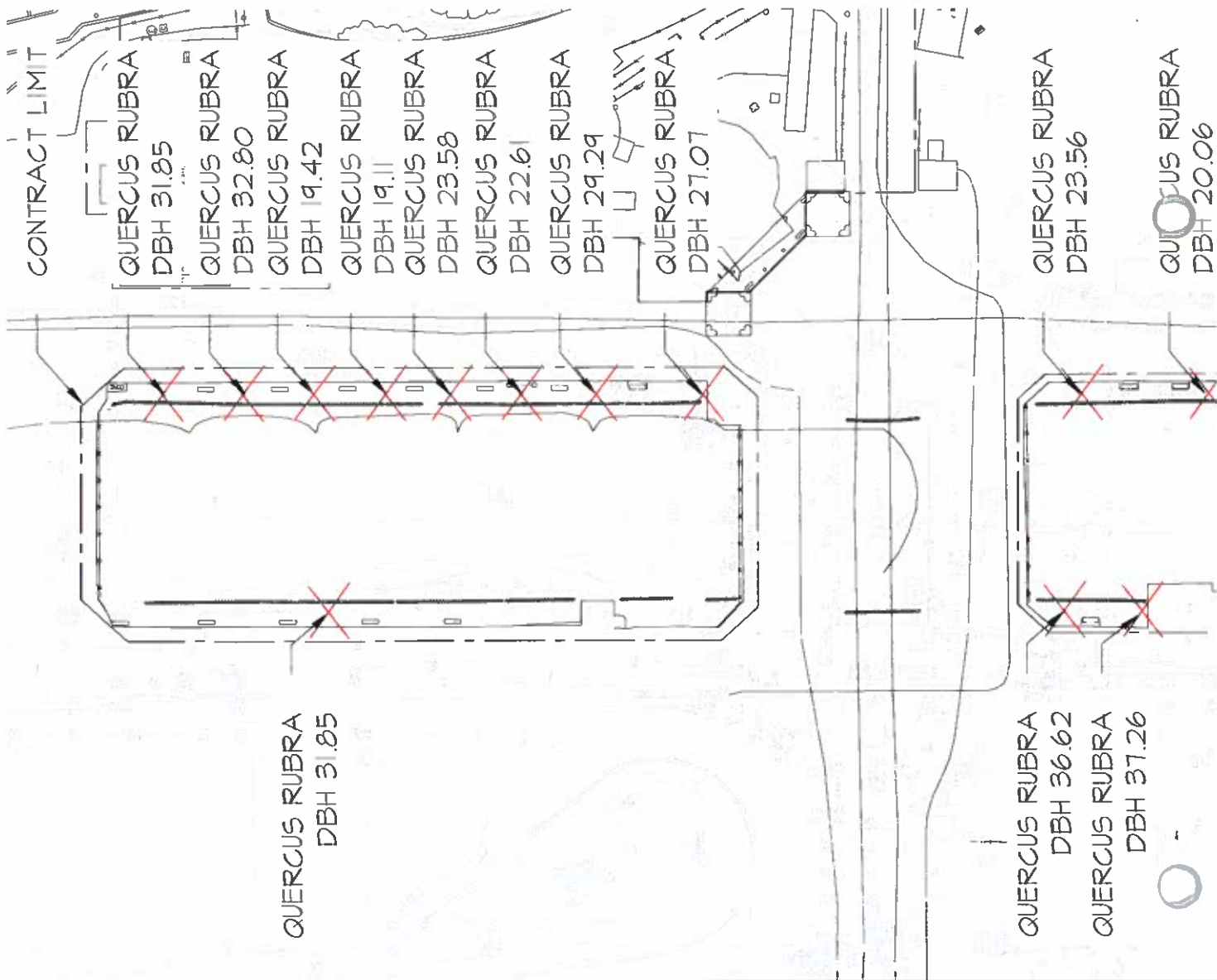
