Overview of the 2025 Tentative Budget

- The proposed 2025 Property Tax Rate is \$216.48 per \$1,000 assessed valuation (6.12% increase)
- Excluding the adjustment for Playland the tax rate increase is 4.22%
- Property Taxes are budgeted to be \$31,459,385
- Total General Fund Operating Expenditures (Excluding Misc. Equipment and Contingency) are budgeted to be \$49,286,658
- The tax levy increase for 2025 is \$1,298,482 (\$427,709 over the NYS Tax Cap)
- The proposed budget results in an increase of \$312 per average household
- The budget assumes Sales Tax Increased by \$100,000. Projected revenues associated with Mortgage Tax, Building Permits, and Interest Income remain unchanged compared to the 2024 budget.
- \$2.825 million designated for City Vehicles & Buildings, Flood Mitigation and Resiliency, and Annual Sewer Maintenance, Storm Water Improvements and Pedestrian Safety
 - > \$1.575 million appropriated from fund balance
 - > \$1.25 million through tax rate
- \$1.5 million designated for Street Resurfacing from State Grants and Aid
- The projected 2024 General Fund Unassigned Fund Balance is estimated to be \$5.027 million, or 10.08% of 2024 Projected Expenditures
- Amount to change tax rate by one percent \$296,442
